Vintage Tours offsets the CO₂ emissions of its classic car journeys and supports a reforestation project in Krailling, Upper Bavaria

Kempten, 11 June 2025 – Vintage Tours, the specialist for guided classic car journeys in Portugal and Spain, is living up to its commitment to offset the CO₂ emissions of its classic vehicles. Through its tree donations, the company supports reforestation projects run by the non-profit organisation myreforest gGmbH. Vintage Tours' contribution is directed towards a reforestation initiative in Krailling, a town in Upper Bavaria.

Vintage Tours has committed to planting one tree for every vehicle that takes part in one of its tours. "This way, we're not only offsetting the emissions from our own fleet but also including the emissions of customers who join our road trips with their own classic cars," explains Matthias Haux, founder of Vintage Tours. "According to calculations by myreforest, a single tree can compensate for the CO₂ emissions of approximately 2,000 kilometres driven in a classic car," he adds.

"As a provider of guided classic car journeys, we see it as our responsibility to take ownership of our ecological footprint and actively work to minimise it as much as possible," says Matthias Haux. Vintage Tours first came across myreforest about two years ago at a classic car fair, where the concept of the organisation immediately convinced Haux. Through its donations to myreforest, Vintage Tours not only offsets the CO₂ emissions generated during its tours but also makes a tangible contribution to the reforestation of regional woodland.

The reforestation project supported by Vintage Tours is located in Krailling, Upper Bavaria, where storm damage and pest infestation have severely affected the forest. Trees are planted in a site-specific and nature-friendly manner to ensure long-term ecological benefits. myreforest monitors the area and documents the growth of the young trees transparently: <https://myreforest.org/project/krailling-bayern>. Every participant is welcome to visit the reforested area at any time.

"Our passion for classic cars and scenic routes does not mean we can ignore environmental concerns. On the contrary – we aim to combine enjoyment and sustainability," Haux continues.
